## Linear route

- 1 Follow the 'Another Place Walking Loop' out of the hotel gardens, through the Ullswater marina and into the fields where the yellow markers continue until the footpaths then narrows up to the main road. This is not suitable for dogs or children.
- 2 Turn right at the road and continue walking until you see the sign for Watermillock Church. Turn left and follow the road for about 1 km. Once past the church (on your left), turn onto the track leading off the road, signposted for the Ullswater Way with daffodil markers. This path winds through the fellside and ancient woodland, offering beautiful views of the mountains surrounding Ullswater Valley.
- 3 Once through the woodland, take the left fork in the path, past the ruins of an old shooting lodge. Head south around Gowbarrow Fell, revealing views of the mountians surrounding the head of Ullswater.
- 4 Descend towards Aira Force, taking care as the path can become slippery when wet.
- 5 Turning left you can head down to the National Trust café and shop, or you can turn right and walk to the waterfalls.
- 6 If you cross the road from the National Trust car park and go through the wooden gate on the other side, this takes you down to the lakeshore and the Ullswater Steamer pier, where you can catch the steamer to Glenridding and onto Pooley Bridge, or take the bus back to Another Place. The main road is dangerous to walk.

A great reward when you reach the top. Catch the Ullswater steamer from the Aira Force jetty back to Pooley Bridge via Glenridding.
