We are focusing on practices aimed at:

- Reducing our consumption of energy (Electricity, Natural Gas, Diesel and Petrol) and water to continue the reduction of our carbon footprint.
- To continue to reduce the overall volume of waste as well as increasing recycling to 80% minimum.
- To work with suppliers that share our sustainability commitment and source locally wherever possible.
- Reducing the use of plastics around our business, removing single use plastic altogether and to move to biodegradable plastics where paper or similar alternatives are not a viable option.
- To raise environmental awareness among staff and make sustainability part of our internal culture.

Our key sustainability priorities are to:

- Continue to purchase Electricity from 100% renewable energy source
- Maintain our biomass boiler and avoid using fossil fuels to provide heat.
- Reduce our impact on the environment by reducing our waste.
- Make purchasing decisions that balance out negative effects on the environment with maintaining a great guest experience and the financial sustainability of our business.
- Support the local economic and social community by maintaining and growing a successful, year round business that employs full time, permanent staff members.
